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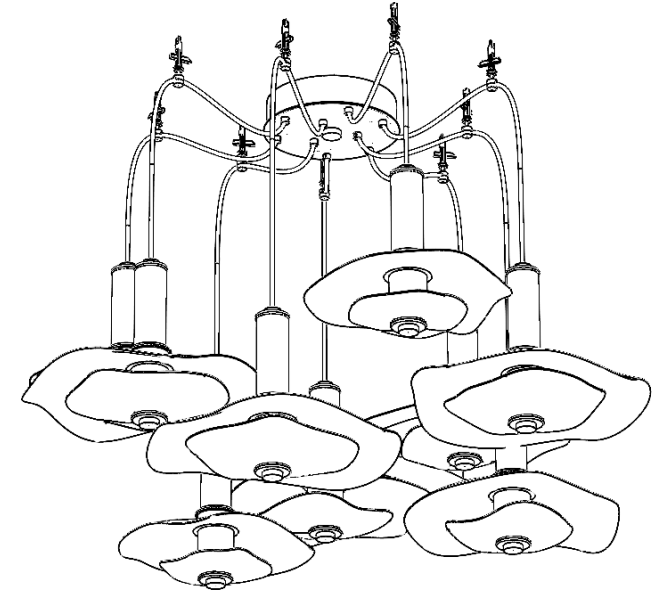

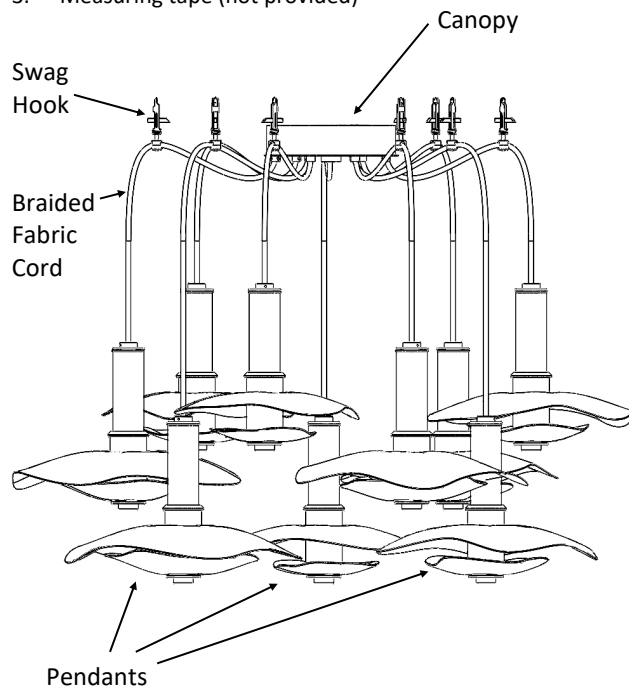

Included Components

- A. Hardware Packet, with Instructions
- B. Canopy
 - B1. Canopy Faceplate
 - B2. Driver(s)
 - B3. Terminal Block(s)
- C. Pendants
 - C1. Pendant Body
 - C2. Small Glass Spacer
 - C3. Inner Metal Disc
 - C4. Large Glass Spacer
 - C5. Outer Metal or Glass Disc
 - C6. Bottom Motif
- D. Swag Hooks

Required Tools

- 1. Philips screw driver (not provided)
- 2. Wire cutters/strippers (not provided)
- 3. Measuring tape (not provided)



Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Mount the canopy to the ceiling using the provided **Mounting Instructions**. Remove canopy faceplate by unscrewing the flat knob in the center of the faceplate. Make wire connections from source power to LED driver. **WHITE to WHITE** and **BLACK to BLACK**.

Step 2: Using the E-Z Toggle Kits (see E-Z Toggle Instructions) included in the Hardware pack, install Swag Hooks radially around where the Canopy will be mounted using a measuring tape to achieve the desired distance.

Step 3: Attach each of the pendants to its respective swag hook, adjusting them to their desired height.

Step 4: Hold the Canopy in the approximate location it will be installed. Run the cloth cord of each of the pendants one at a time through the canopy faceplate unit it reached the desired sag between the canopy and the swag hook and tighten the cord grip using a flat blade screw driver. The cord grip is on the Faceplate, DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN. THIS MAY DAMAGE THE FIXTURE.

Step 5: cut cords to length and re-strip the end to prepare for wire connections. Be sure to leave at least 6" of length for wire connections.

WARNING

DO NOT DIRECTLY CONNECT LEDs TO AC POWER.

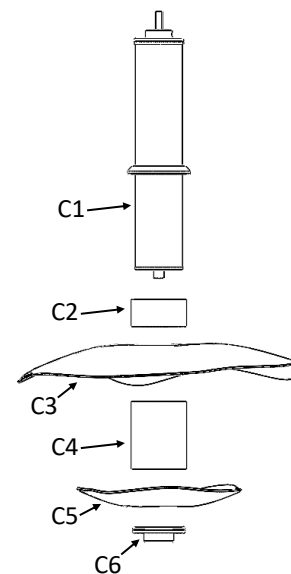
LEDs will be damaged if exposed to high voltages. The LEDs must be wired as described to the included driver to work properly.

Step 6: Connect the **PURPLE** (negative) driver wire to the **BLACK** wires from all of the pendants using wire nuts. Connect the **RED** (positive) driver wire to the **WHITE** wires from all of the pendants using wire nuts.

Step 7: Install Faceplate onto Canopy and screw Flat Knob onto the IP in the center of the canopy to secure the Faceplate.

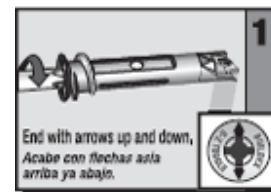
Step 8: Assemble the Glass Spacers (C2,C4) and Discs (C3,C5) in the order shown in the image. Secure the Spacers and Discs by threading the Bottom Motif (C6) onto the Pendant Body (C1). Repeat for each pendant, arranging the different Disc sizes as desired

NOTE
The Inner and Outer Discs will each be marked with a size (SM, MD, LG). Ensure that on a single pendant there is matching Inner and Outer Disc sizes. LG-LG SM-SM etc.

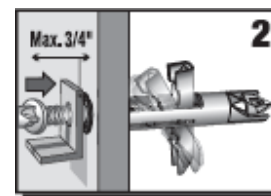


E-Z Toggle™ Instructions

Turn E-Z Toggle into drywall until seated flush. Arrows on head indicate direction toggle clamp will open. End with arrows up and down.



Place fixture over E-Z Toggle. Push screw into E-Z Toggle to engage clamp



Turn screw until it stops. Toggle clamp tightens against drywall as screw is turned.
